Medication-Assisted Treatment Reentry Program

Section 425 (4)

The department shall submit a report by September 30 to the senate and house appropriations subcommittees on corrections, the senate and house fiscal agencies, the legislative corrections ombudsman, and the state budget office on the number of offenders who received injections upon release, the number of offenders who received injections and tested positive for drugs or alcohol, the number of offenders who received injections in the community for a duration of at least 3 months, and the number of offenders who received injections and were subsequently returned to prison.

Number of offenders who received injections upon release	214	58
Number of offenders who received injections and tested positive for drugs/alcohol	4	1
Number of offenders who received injections in the community for a duration of at least 3 months	38	13
Number of offenders who received injections and were subsequently returned to prison	0	0

- **There are 68 out 272 that have not been paroled long enough to meet the 3 injections in the community criteria**
