**SUBJECT:** 2021 Individuals with Disabilities Education Act Public Reporting of Data

Federal regulations implementing the federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) (§300.602(b)(1)(i)(A)) require public reporting on the performance of each local education agency (LEA), both traditional public school districts and public school academies (PSAs), on targets established in the State Performance Plan/Annual Performance Report (SPP/APR) for each Part B priority area (ages 3 through 21). Each LEA will have an opportunity to analyze and review the intermediate school district (ISD) data in comparison to the established state targets prior to the SPP/APR public release.

The SPP/APR for Part B is comprised of results and compliance indicators. The 2021 public reporting data are from the 2018-2019 and 2019-2020 school years. Part B indicators predominantly reflect data the LEA has submitted to the state. For Part B, the following results and compliance indicators are being publicly reported:

- Indicator 1 - Graduation
- Indicator 2 - Dropout
- Indicator 3 - Statewide Assessment – *Reporting Waived for FFY 2019*
- Indicator 4A - Suspension/Expulsion
- Indicator 4B - Suspension/Expulsion by Race/Ethnicity
- Indicator 5 - Educational Environments: Ages 6-21
- Indicator 6 - Early Childhood Educational Environments: Ages 3-5
- Indicator 7 - Preschool Outcomes
- Indicator 8 - Parent Involvement
- Indicator 9 - Disproportionate Representation (Child with a Disability)
- Indicator 10 - Disproportionate Representation (Eligibility Categories)
- Indicator 11 - Child Find
- Indicator 12 - Early Childhood Transition
- Indicator 13 - Secondary Transition
- Indicator 14 - Postsecondary Outcomes

LEAs and ISDs will be able to preview data for children and students ages 3 through 21 for a two-week period beginning approximately May 12, 2021, prior to the required public reporting date of June 1. LEAs will be notified when the data are available to be previewed in a separate communication.

The publicly reported data will be posted by June 1, 2021, on the [MI School Data Portal](#). Links to the MI School Data Portal will also be available through the [Michigan Department of Education](#) website.
